

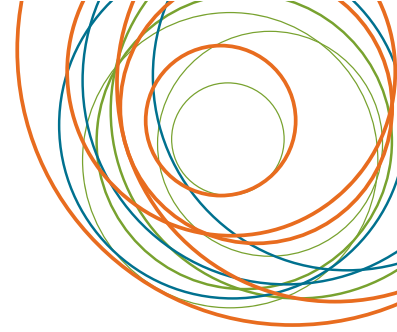

ART SPACES AT DAREBIN LIBRARIES



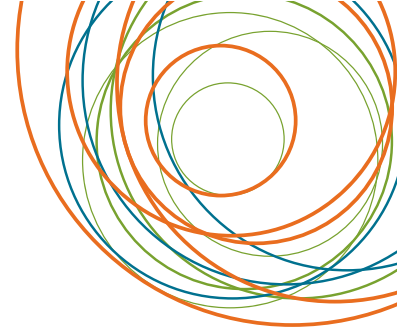
Darebin Libraries offers art spaces at Northcote, Fairfield and Reservoir libraries free of charge to artists, community groups and schools for a period of four weeks.

The LibArt Gallery is located at Northcote Library, just a short walk from lively High St, Northcote. The library attracts over 165,000 visitors each year. The gallery is available to exhibit hanging artworks. It has 17 metres of brick wall display space with adjustable lighting and ottoman seating.

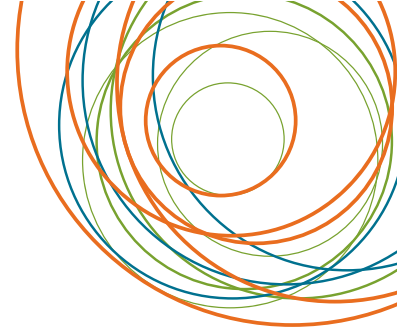
GLASS DISPLAY CASE

A lockable modular glass display case is available to exhibit small works.

Dimensions
1710mm high x 400 mm wide x 400mm deep
with four shelves set at 280mm apart.

Fairfield Library is located in the Fairfield Community Centre, in the heart of the busy Station St shopping district.

There are four lockable display cases built into the wall of the library and community centre walkway. They are available to exhibit three dimensional works or smaller framed pieces. A tracking system and various hanging wires are available in each display case.

DISPLAY CASE 1

Located at the Arthur St entrance, outside the community centre.

Dimensions

1200mm wide x 420mm deep

With two shelves with heights as follows:

Top 592mm

Middle 390mm

Bottom 395mm

DISPLAY CASE 2

Located above the library's return chute in the middle of the community centre walkway.

Dimensions

1780mm wide x 680 mm high x 540mm deep

DISPLAY CASE 3

Located in the community centre walkway.

Dimensions

1990mm wide x 905mm high x 295mm deep

DISPLAY CASE 4

Located in the community centre near the Station St entrance.

Dimensions

610mm wide x 615mm high x 290mm deep

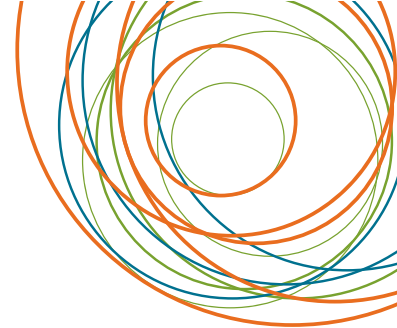

RESERVOIR LIBRARY



ADDRESS

HOURS

Monday – Thurs 10am to 8pm
Friday 10am to 5pm
Saturday 10am to 4pm

Reservoir Library is located behind the busy Edwards St shopping district.

There is a set of three lockable display cases in the library foyer. The cases have glass shelving and a back board which can be used for information displays and posters. All visitors to the library pass the display cases so they can be a great way to promote your club, community group or artwork.

END CASES

Dimensions
1440mm wide x 1650mm high x 260mm deep
With two shelves with heights as follows:
Top 820mm high
Middle 400mm high
Bottom 430mm high

MIDDLE CASE

Dimensions
Height and width as for the two end cases, however as this case projects out, the depth differs:
260 mm and 450mm
Glass hinged door – 540mm wide

Please note: the board surface on the back of the display cases is not suitable for pins or tacks. Velcro, 3M clear mounting tape or a staple gun are recommended.

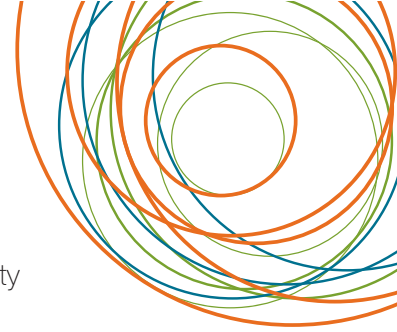

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USE



- Darebin Libraries reserves the right to approve all exhibitions, determine the suitability of display materials and reject inappropriate displays.
- Exhibitors are responsible for curating, installing and removing displays. Exhibitions must be developed in partnership with Darebin Libraries to ensure a high standard of visual presentation.
- All opening functions or exhibition launches are at the expense of the exhibitor. The exhibitor shall leave the display or exhibition space in a clean, safe condition. Events must be scheduled during library opening hours and in consultation with the Marketing Officer.
- Pins, tacks or tape are not to be used on the surfaces inside displays cases or on the surface of the walls in the hanging art spaces. Exhibitors are responsible for arranging display stands if required to prop up works.
- Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring that they abide by Occupational Health & Safety guidelines (for details please refer to the Manual Handling Code of Practice) at all times in the library. Glass shelving inside the display cases may not be moved. Any hazard, incident or injury should be reported to Darebin Libraries staff immediately.
- Property is left in the care of Darebin Libraries at the owner/exhibitor's risk. It is recommended that insurance be taken out for items included in exhibitions.
- Darebin Libraries is unable to handle sales or information enquiries about works on display. Exhibitors must provide contact details for display with the exhibition and a price list where applicable.
- Any publicity produced or distributed by the exhibitor must not state or imply that Darebin Libraries is responsible for the exhibitor's exhibition or event, other than as the provider of the venue.
- Promotional materials prepared to a professional standard in a DL or A4 format can be displayed in the library at the Customer Service Desk. Display of promotional materials is at the discretion of Darebin Libraries.
- Exhibitors give permission for information regarding their exhibition and its creator/s, plus images relevant to the exhibition (e.g. photos of artworks) to be published on the Darebin Libraries website.
